Joe – not our intent to revoke, but our hope is that we can solve problem – OPP need more information.

Mrs. *Stickel* – If people are underage they are breaking the law, and will continue to break.

Mrs. *Evans* – tourism will be impacted if parents can't control their kids why should council or the OPP have to.

Joe - not necessarily solution

Andrew Van Oosten – OPP have had extra patrols here but we got complaints that they were here too much

Francoise - a town is a town and the same rules apply

Mrs. Arney - what about putting up signage?

Joe - I've thought of the same thing.

Mrs. Arney - Signs, or radar controlled, etc.

Citizen – not just people from out of town

Mr. Gilmore – Council refuses to do something themselves.

Joe – Council is looking at long term effects of the problem

Jeanette and Carrie Anne – putting info on the website.

Mrs. Arney – Brochure at businesses in town

Joe - New intern will make it a point. Thank you.

Andrew George - We are one of only a few towns that allow ATV's to ride on the streets.
